Gorilla Tracking in Bwindi Impenetrable National Park, Uganda
with luxury accommodation

Day 1

Today morning you will fly from Entebbe International Airport to Kihikihi, close to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. The scenic flight takes about 1, 5-2 hours. At the airstrip a car and driver will be waiting for you and transfer you to your hotel which is in the national park. In the afternoon you can go for a community walk or a pleasant forest walk.

Day 2

Day of the GORILLA TRACKING!



It's once in a lifetime experience! There are less than 800 mountain gorillas left in the world.

They belong to one of the world most endangered apes

After a short introduction you will start the tracking at 8.30 am. Your journey to see our second

closest relatives in the wild can take from 30 min up to even 6-7 hours.

In most cases you will hike through the lush rainforest, cross hills and valleys while your guide will cut the vegetation in front of you with a machete till you reach the gentle giants. **You can**

If the tracking does not last too long you can do **other activities** around or in the park.

Some options for activities:

A: **Community walk** where you will visit a local school and hospital. You will be taken to the home of pygmies (forest people) who were dislocated from the forest when Bwindi became a national park. You will go through the process of local brew making where you can also taste the products. The traditional healer will introduce some of the medicinal plants used for different diseases.

B: **Bycicle riding** in and around the National Park

C: **Forest walk.** Here you can choose from different routes in the forest and have a pleasant walk or riding through the lush rainforest and get more familiar with the environment where you will track the gorillas the next day.

Accommodation: in the National Park

Day 3

Today you will say good bye to the forest and fly back to Entebbe. If your flight is tonight than you will stay at the airport, but if you wish to stay longer and extend your safari then we can arrange accommodation for you in Kampala or Entebbe.

Since our tours are private, **departure** can be organized **anytime** throughout the year. **Permits** are **discounted in November** (instead of USD 600 they cost only USD 350).

Rainy season is usually in October, November, March and April but you can still have luck and catch sunny and warm days in these months. Sometimes it rains in the high season as well. But please do not forget that gorillas live in rainforests!

Price includes

- Flight ENT-Kihihi
- Airstrip transfers from Kihihi to Buhoma and back in a 4x4 vehicle
- Transfer from the hotel to the tracking point and back
- 2 nights accommodations in Buhoma (db room on full board in a luxury lodge)
- **1 Gorilla permit: 600 \$/person**
- Park entry fees and guide fees on the day of tracking

Price does not include

- International Airfares
- Visa fees (US\$50 for Uganda)
- Travel insurance
- Optional activities
- Tips
- Personal spending money for souvenirs etc.
- All drinks
- Medical expenses, such as malaria prevention

Note:
